

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

All interested persons are hereby notified that the Historic Preservation Board of the City of Coral Gables, Florida, will conduct the following public hearing at a regular meeting scheduled for Wednesday, December 16, 2009, at the City of Coral Gables, City Hall, 405 Biltmore Way, Coral Gables, Florida. The public hearing will begin at 4:00 p.m. in the Second Floor City Commission Chambers to consider the following matters:

### LOCAL HISTORIC DESIGNATION:

1. CASE FILE LHD 2009-007 Consideration of the local historic designation of the property at 2842 De Soto Boulevard, legally described as the West ½ of Lot 6 and all of Lot 7, Block 18, Coral Gables Country Club Section Part One, according to the Plat thereof, recorded in Plat Book 8, Page 108, of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

### SPECIAL CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATENESS:

1. CASE FILE COA (SP) 2009-23 An application for the issuance of a Special Certificate of Appropriateness for the property at 255-265 Aragon Avenue, a local historic landmark, legally described as Lots 33-41, Block 34, Coral Gables Section "K", as recorded in Plat Book 8, at Page 33, of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The applicant is requesting design approval for the installation of signage. A variance will be required from Article 5, Division 19, Section 5-1904 of the Coral Gables "Zoning Code" to allow the building to have a wall mounted sign on the North elevation (alley).

2. CASE FILE COA (SP) 2009-25 An application for the issuance of a Special Certificate of Appropriateness for the property at 820 Alhambra Circle, a local historic landmark, legally described as Lots 16 and 17, Block 32, Coral Gables Section "B", as recorded in Plat Book 5, at Page 111, of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The applicant is requesting design approval for the construction of an addition and alterations to the residence. A variance will be required from Article 4, Division 1, Section 4-101 (D) (9) and Section 4-101 (D) (10) of the Coral Gables "Zoning Code" for the building to exceed the allowable maximum square foot floor area.

3. CASE FILE COA (SP) 2009-27 An application for the issuance of a Special Certificate of Appropriateness for the property at 1228 Alhambra Circle, a contributing structure within the "Alhambra Circle Historic District," legally described as Lots 9, 10, and 11, Block 4, Coral Gables Section E, as recorded in Plat Book 8, at Page 13, of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The applicant is requesting design approval for the construction of a new covered entry porch.

4. CASE FILE COA (SP) 2009-28 Continued An application for the issuance of a Special Certificate of Appropriateness for the property at 547 Aragon Avenue, a local historic landmark, legally described as Lots 23 and 24, Block 10, Coral Gables Section "B", according to the Plat thereof, recorded in Plat Book 5, Page 111, of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The applicant is requesting design approval for interior alterations, and the installation of windows and doors. This application is a result of a violation.

Interested persons may express their views at the hearing or file them in writing with the undersigned on or before the date of the Historic Preservation Board meeting. NOTE: Any person, who acts as a lobbyist pursuant to the City of Coral Gables, must register with the City Clerk, prior to engaging in lobbying activities before City Staff, Boards, Committees and/or the City Commission. Any aggrieved party may appeal any decision of the Historic Preservation Board to the City Commission by filing a written Notice of Appeal and the applicable appeal fee with the City Clerk within ten (10) days from the date of the decision. The notice shall concisely set forth the decision appealed and the grounds for the appeal. If any person decides to appeal any decision made with respect to any matter considered at this public meeting or hearing, the aggrieved party will need a record of the proceedings. For such purpose the aggrieved party may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is based.
