- Appoint a Campaign Treasurer a candidate may be his own Treasurer or Deputy Treasurer.
- Complete Form <u>DS-DE 9</u> "Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Campaign Depository" and deliver the original form to the Office of the City Clerk, City of Coral Gables, 405 Biltmore Way, Coral Gables, Florida 33134.
- Open a campaign account at a bank authorized to do business in the State of Florida which must be separate from any personal or business accounts the bank should provide you with deposit slips and checks indicating it is a campaign account.
- File the <u>DS-DE 84</u> "Statement of Candidate" Form with the City Clerk within ten days of filing Form DS-DE 9 upon filing of this form, the candidate may begin to collect and spend monies for the campaign.

#### QUALIFYING INFORMATION

A candidate shall qualify for the 2023 Municipal Election in the Office of City Clerk, City of Coral Gables, 405 Biltmore Way, Coral Gables, Florida. The qualifying period begins at 12:00 noon on February 20, 2023 and ends at 12:00 noon on February 24, 2023. Candidates may only file their qualifying papers with the City Clerk during this period.

The following will be necessary for the filing of a candidacy:

- Form DS-DE 84 "Statement of Candidate"
- Form DS-DE9 "Appointment of Campaign Treasurer"
- Qualifying Fee (\$200.00) During the qualifying period, a candidate also pays an assessment fee of 1% of the salary of the office sought.
  - Mayor/Group 1 (\$435.97)
  - Commission/Group IV (\$354.26 Assessment Fee)
  - Commission/Group V (\$354.26 Assessment Fee)

- Candidate Oath (Non-Partisan Office)/Oath of Candidate (DS-DE 24B)
- Statement of Financial Interests 2020 (Form 1)
- Letter of Resignation (Resign to run, if applicable, pursuant to City Charter Section 8 60 days prior to the date of the Election, effective 3 days following the election)
- Biography/Resume
- Proof of Residency/ Proof of Citizenship/ Proof of Registered Voter Status
- Declaration of Candidate Intent
- <u>Voluntary Declaration and First Amendment Waiver (for Candidates who agree to comply with</u> the Voluntary Statement of Fair Campaign Practices)
- <u>Declaration for Candidates Not Automatically Covered by the Mandatory Provisions of the</u>
  Miami-Dade Ethical Campaign Practices Ordinance Miami-Dade County Code at 2-11.1(c)(1)
- <u>Undue Burden Oath</u> (if applicable)
