Enhance your history of Coral Gables with a tour of the beautiful
Historic Merrick House Museum
located at 907 Coral Way

Step back in time to the Roaring Twenties when visiting the Coral Gables Merrick House, which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. View 14 rooms on your docent-guided tour, and afterwards stroll the 1.3 acre grounds to see the historic grotto filled with 10 species of fish, the Heritage Garden, and the lily pond. The expansive wraparound porch is set amongst the flora for a beautiful backdrop for photographs.
