RE: Legal Opinion Regarding Beer and Wine License

Date: September 6, 2017

I have reviewed your email and find that the facts you have presented are consistent with prior opinions my office has given (see, e.g., CAO 2014-060), which allows issuance of a beer and wine license (2-COP) to your restaurant by the City as long as you are a bona fide restaurant with seating and do not serve alcohol from a counter or bar. You must obtain any necessary approvals or licenses from other government entities as well, such as the State of Florida. I am asking Assistant City Attorney Cristina Suarez to work with you and Sebrina to effectuate this opinion, which is issued pursuant to section 2-201(e)(1) and (8) of the City Code.

Please note, one clarification: the restaurant cannot serve alcohol from a counter or bar. An example of an opinion I find analogous is CAO 2014-060,
