Consistent with the Justice Advocate Program, please advise whenever a criminal matter occurring within the jurisdiction of Coral Gables is nolle prossed or otherwise dismissed by the State Attorney's Office, so that it can be reviewed for potential prosecution by the City Attorney's Office as a municipal ordinance violation or for potential enforcement of Ordinance No. 2016-39 (amending section 38-1 of the City Code) as a code enforcement matter. Of course, the City will evaluate each matter on the specific facts and law, and exercise appropriate prosecutorial discretion in bringing any action. I am copying the Director of Public Safety, Chief of Police, and Code Enforcement Director as well so that they are aware.
