MAP LEGEND

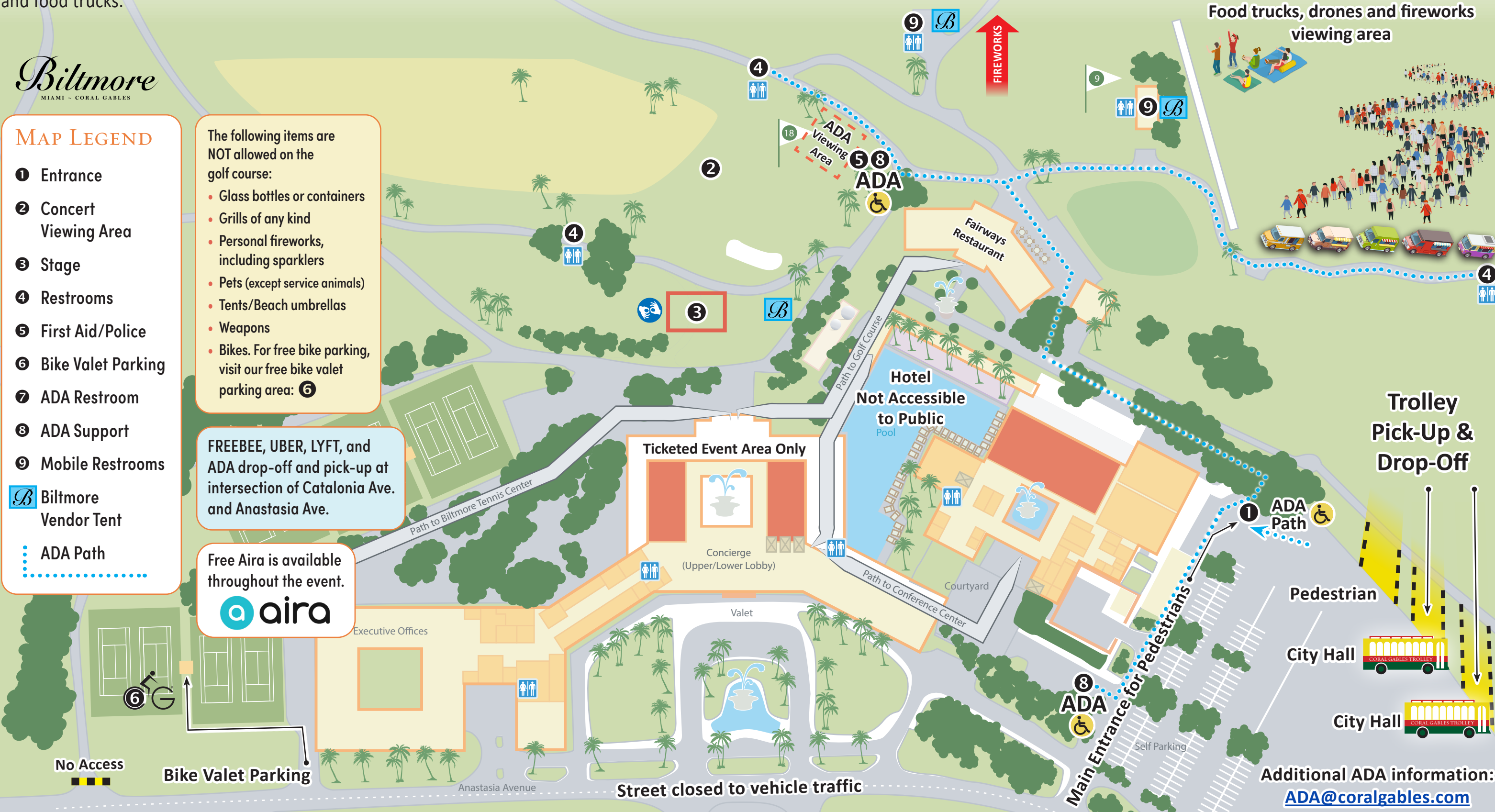
