About The NBS™

The National Business Survey $^{\text{TM}}$ (The NBS) gives local businesses the opportunity to provide feedback about the community characteristics and local government services that help support the local economy. It was developed by the survey experts from National Research Center (NRC) at Polco.

Great communities are partnerships of the government, businesses in the private sector, community-based organizations, and residents, all geographically connected. With this report, the City of Coral Gables gains an important perspective from its businesses across six core indicators of the business environment in the community:

- Community amenities
- Business climate
- Employment opportunities and workforce support
- Workforce readiness
- · Business growth
- Governance

This report provides the opinions of 110 business owners and managers of the City of Coral Gables. Because the survey was intended to be taken by all businesses in the community, no traditional margin of error was calculated. However, because not all businesses responded, NRC recommends using plus or minus ten percentage points as the "range of uncertainty" around any given percent reported for the City as a whole. The full description of methods used to gather these opinions can be found in the "Methods" tab. No statistical weighting was performed.



How the results are reported

For the most part, the percentages presented in the following tabs represent the "percent positive." Most commonly, the percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good and very safe/somewhat safe, etc.). On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer "don't know." The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab "Complete data." However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in most of the tabs. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

Comparisons to benchmarks

NRC's database of comparative business opinion is comprised of business perspectives gathered in surveys from communities whose business owners and/or managers evaluated the same kinds of topics on The National Business Survey. NRC adds the latest results quickly upon survey completion, keeping the benchmark data fresh and relevant. Comparisons are made to the entire database. Ratings are compared when there are at least five communities in which a similar question was asked. In each tab, Coral Gables' results are noted as being "higher" than the benchmark, "lower" than the benchmark, or "similar" to the benchmark, meaning that the average rating given by Coral Gables business owners and managers is statistically similar to or different (greater or lesser) than the benchmark. Being rated as "higher" or "lower" than the benchmark means that Coral Gables' average rating for a particular item was more than five points different than the benchmark.

Methods

The National Business Survey was developed to provide communities an accurate, affordable and easy way to assess and local business owners' and managers' perspectives about the economic environment of a community or district. Standardization of common questions and survey methods provide the rigor to assure valid results.

Selecting survey recipients

All private sector businesses within the City of Coral Gables were eligible to participate in the survey. A list of all businesses within the zip codes serving Coral Gables was purchased from InfoUSA. Each location was mapped and compared to the most current boundary file for the jurisdiction and business addresses located outside of Coral Gables were removed from consideration.

Conducting the survey

Businesses received mailings beginning on March 20th, 2025 and the survey remained open for 6 weeks. The first mailing was a postcard inviting the business owner or manager to participate in the survey. The next mailing contained an invitation letter with instructions, followed by a reminder postcard. All mailings included a web link for respondents to complete the survey online.

Because the survey was intended to be taken by all businesses in the community, no traditional margin of error was calculated. However, because not all businesses responded, NRC recommends using plus or minus ten percentage points as the "range of uncertainty" around any given percent reported for the city as a whole.

Analyzing the survey

Responses from the surveys completed on Polco were downloaded. Range checks as well as others forms of quality control were also performed. No statistical weighting was performed. No adjustments were made for design effects.

The survey datasets were analyzed using all or some of a combination of the Statistical Package for the Social Sciences (SPSS), R, Python and Tableau. For the most part, the percentages presented in the reports represent the "percent positive." The percent positive is the combination of the top two most positive response options (i.e., excellent/good, very safe/somewhat safe, and essential/very important, etc.), or, in the case of resident behaviors/participation, the percent positive represents the proportion of respondents indicating "yes" or participating in an activity at least once a month.

On many of the questions in the survey respondents may answer "don't know." The proportion of respondents giving this reply is shown in the full set of responses included in the tab "Complete data". However, these responses have been removed from the analyses presented in the reports. In other words, the tables and graphs display the responses from respondents who had an opinion about a specific item.

Study Limitations

All survey research is subject to unmeasured error. While the methodologies employed for this survey were designed to minimize this error as much as possible, these other sources of potential error should be acknowledged, and can include non-response error, coverage error, recall bias and social desirability bias. Non-response error arises when those who were selected to participate in the survey did not do so, and may have different opinions or experiences that survey responders. Coverage error refers to the fact that the source used to select survey recipients may not include every business in a community; this is quite common with lists of businesses. In addition, the survey invitation may be correctly sent to a business, but it may not be directed to a person who has the knowledge and authority to respond to the survey. Respondents may not fully know the history or experiences of the company (e.g., how much of a problem certain issues were across the entire company, or how long the company has been in operation), and for some survey items they may answer in ways they think cast their responses in a more favorable light (recall bias and social desirability bias).

Key Findings

Highest-performing areas:

- About 9 out of 10 business owners and managers rated Coral Gables as an excellent or good place to do business, ranking higher than the national benchmark. Likewise, respondents offered above-average ratings for the job the Coral Gables government does at attracting new businesses, informing businesses of community issues and values, retaining existing businesses, welcoming business involvement, and supporting or creating new jobs.
- Ratings also exceeded the national benchmark for the variety and quality of employment opportunities, as well as the availability of jobs that pay a livable wage.
- Business owners and managers largely agreed on workforce readiness, with 8 in 10 indicating that current employees and employment options possess both the skills and qualifications needed.
- Owners and manager in Coral Gables faced lesser challenges in certain areas in finding good employees than
 those in other communities nationwide. These included failed drug tests, too many overqualified
 employees/applicants, too many workers without a high school degree or equivalent, lack of higher education
 opportunities, and lack of trade schools and other adult training programs.

Potential areas of focus:

- Respondents shared some concerns regarding housing and cost of living for the workforce in the community, with
 one quarter of respondents offering positive ratings for the variety of housing options for people who work in Coral
 Gables as well as the cost of living, and only 1 in 10 giving positive marks for affordable housing for people who
 work in Coral Gables.
- Parking availability was also a concern for owners and managers, with 3 in 10 positively rating the ease of parking at workplaces, and 4 in 10 doing the same for the amount of parking in commercial areas, both ranking lower than the benchmark.
- Owners and managers in Coral Gables faced greater challenges in certain areas in finding good employees than
 those in other communities nationwide. These included cost of living, lack of affordable quality housing, too many
 under-qualified employees/applicants, too few applicants/employees who speak a language other than English, and
 lack of childcare opportunities.


Other notable results:

- A higher-than-average proportion of businesses plan to hire in the next 6-12 months. Of those planning to hire...
 - o 74% plan to hire for skilled jobs
 - o 57% plan to hire for highly skilled jobs
 - o 51% plan to hire for semi-skilled jobs
 - o 37% plan to hire for unskilled jobs
- Of the respondents who reported either having requested an inspection online or applied for a permit online,
 60% reported excellent or good quality of service provided by both the Electronic Permitting System as well as City Inspectors.
- Likewise, among those who reported either having requested an inspection online or applied for a permit online, around half offered positive ratings for the time it takes to pull a permit, the ease of pulling a permit, and their overall satisfaction with the commercial permitting process.
- When considering their business's commercial area, about 8 in 10 respondents gave high marks for landscaping in the public right-of-way, building facades of neighboring structures, and the amount of residential dwellings.
- Around 7 in 10 respondents reported that they lease their place of business, and 7 in 10 of those that lease felt that the price per square foot was somewhat or much higher in Coral Gables than other neighboring cities.
- Three-quarters of owners and managers agreed that, from a business perspective, there are enough events downtown.
- When asked about closing hours, 16% of businesses reported closing before 5p.m., 61% of businesses have closing hours between 5p.m. and 6:30p.m., and 18% have closing hours sometime after 7p.m.

Quality of life

A community with an excellent quality of life for those who live and work there will be appealing to those wanting to start a new business and is important in attracting and retaining good employees. A highly livable community is attractive, accessible, and welcoming to all.



The third column is the rank assigned to Coral Gables' rating among communities where a similar question was asked. The fourth column is the number of communities that asked a similar question. The fifth column shows the percentile for Coral Gables' result -- that is what percent of surveyed communities had a lower rating than Coral Gables.


