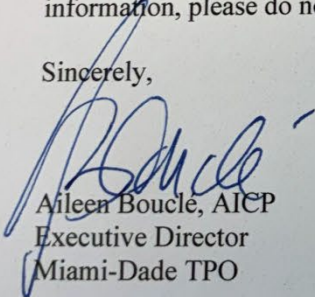
The Miami-Dade Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) Governing Board has recommended awarding the City of Coral Gables (City) up to \$60,000.00 for the "Pedestrian Master Plan" in accordance with the TPO's Municipal Grant Program section of the Unified Planning Work Program.

Following this recommendation, the next step in the grant process is the execution of an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) between the TPO and the City and a draft of the ILA is attached for your review. Prior to finalizing the ILA, the City must first submit a Scope of Services, Project Schedule, Project Cost (which reflects the local match requirement), and E-Verify Certification. Please provide these documents and a signed "Condition of Award" form (attached) to Ms. Jessica J. Lopez, by September 30, 2026. These documents will be incorporated into the final ILA, which will be returned to the City for signature. A Notice-to-Proceed letter will be provided to the City once the ILA is fully executed by both parties. Please note that no work shall commence on the "Pedestrian Master Plan" until the ILA and receipt of the Notice-to-Proceed letter are finalized.

Thank you for participating in the Municipal Grant Program. We look forward to working with Ms. Anamy Garcia, Grants and Internal Audit Coordinator, and her staff in producing this important transportation-related product.
